The General Secretariat of the Organization of American States (GS/OAS) and the University of Tennessee, Knoxville, in the United States have decided to support outstanding individuals from the Americas by awarding the following academic scholarships to continue their studies.

APPLICATION DEADLINE:	University admission and scholarship application: Fall 2023: April 30, 2023 Open to admitted students from OAS member states, except the United States, starting Fall 2023.
BENEFITS:	 The University of Tennessee, Knoxville, will offer for Undergraduate students: a. a reduced tuition rate of USD 20,000 per year for undergraduate students – review the estimated annual cost here. b. waiver of the application fee for applicants c. Applicants may also be eligible for UT's out-of-state scholarships, the International Volunteer or International Tennessee Explore Scholarship. Applicants would need to meet the additional scholarship criteria d. Applicants may apply for competitive scholarships adhering to the application (November 1st) and competitive scholarship deadline dates. The OAS will provide a one-time supplementary amount of USD 4,000 to support tuition for scholarship recipients

Scholarship benefits are subject to the academic performance of the scholarship recipient and subject to the availability of funds. To receive these benefits, the scholarship recipient must not be reported with an unsatisfactory academic performance due to absences or failing courses.

- Applicants must be admitted to the University of Tennessee to be considered for the OAS- University of Tennessee Scholarship through the university.

EXPENSES NOT COVERED BY THIS SCHOLARSHIP

Expenses not covered by this scholarship, falling under the sole responsibility of the scholarship recipients, are as follows:

- a) remaining tuition cost;
- b) application fees;
- c) housing costs;
- d) meal plans;
- e) round trip airfare;
- f) health insurance fees;
- g) books and study materials;
- h) orientation fees; and
- i) any additional charges not expressly covered by the OAS-UT PAEC Scholarship.

Applicants can also apply for the Rowe Fund at OAS:: Leo S. Rowe Pan American Fund, which is an educational loan programme of the OAS that helps citizens from Latin America and the Caribbean to finance their studies in accredited universities across the United States by awarding interest-free loans of up to US\$15,000 dollars.

 Be admitted to an undergraduate programme by the University of Tennessee, Knoxville;

- This scholarship opportunity is open to new applicants as well as current University
 of Tennessee, Knoxville, students from an OAS member state, except the United
 States; and
- Be a citizen or legal resident of any of the OAS Member States.

The following applicants are not eligible:

- Current OAS Scholarship recipients and citizens and/or permanent residents of the United States;
- GS/OAS staff and their immediate family members or GS/OAS consultants; and
- Permanent OAS staff members and their immediate family members.
